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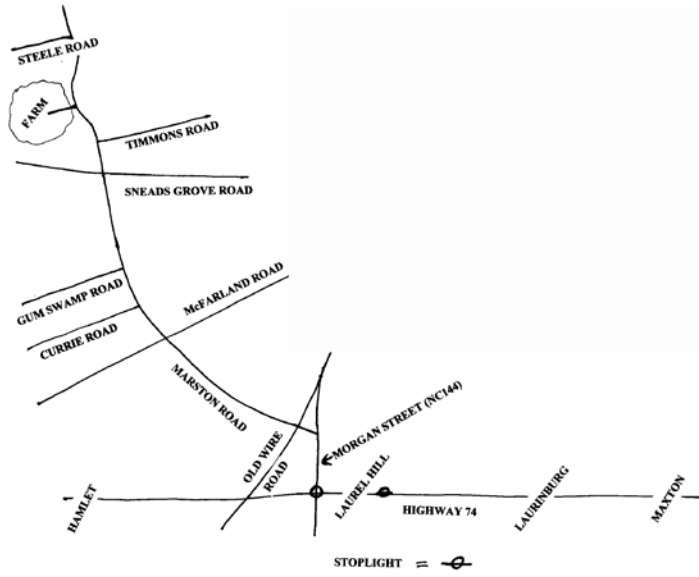
Klahican World Tour continued....

Travel US Hwy 74 West to Laurinburg, Take US Hwy 74 By-pass around Laurinburg. Travel Bypass around Laurinburg, Go about 8 miles on US Hwy 74 to the community of Laurel Hill
 At the 2nd Stoplight on US Hwy 74, Turn RIGHT onto Morgan Street (NC Hwy 144) (BSA Sign)
 After turning, Pate's Village Foods on your left, First Bank on your right
 Go 3/10 mile, Turn LEFT onto Marston Road (BSA Sign)
 Go 1/10 mile to stop sign, cross over Old Wire Road
 Continue on Marston Road for 9 3/10 miles, thru Marston Road / McFarland Road Intersection
 Pass Currie Road on the left, Pass Gum Swamp Road on left
 Cross through Marston Road / Sneys Grove Road Intersection, Church on your right
 Pass Timmons Road on right, yellow house on right
 If you see Steele Road on your left – you have gone too far
 Road curves to right, In Curve, turn LEFT, go through metal farm gate (BSA Sign)
 Sign on right side of farm gate says "Glenlivet"
 Large mobile home sits across from entrance to Glenlivet (McCoy Farm) entrance
 Continue down farm road about 1/4 mile to pond and first cabin.
